

## INDOOR ANCHORING

PhunZone play structures are primarily designed to be portable, that is, capable of being moved to different locations, particularly in those facilities with limited space.

While Phunzone systems are very stable, many locations prefer to have some form of anchoring to meet licensing requirements and to reduce the chance of theft.


The anchoring we offer is not "permanent" (no concrete footings), but are designed to be removable. They can be used for long term anchoring if required.

Indoor anchoring system works with any "hard" flooring surface you can drill into



## Screw-down

- Construct the "base" level of the playcenter Place the base in the final set-up location
- Note: best not against a wall or it will be difficult to assemble
- Drill through the bottom of at least the 4 corner connectors
- Install floor anchors if necessary (plastic or metal)
- Screw in anchoring screws into the surfacing or into the anchors





Electrical Conduit Clamps

- Good way to attach either to the floor or against a wall
- Will only work on tubes not attached to panels
- Need 1 1/2" grey U-shaped conduit clamps (Home Depot)
- We prefer plastic to metal for safety reasons
- Put clamp on tube and mark clamp screw hole locations
- Attach the clamp to floor with appropriate screws and washers
- You also have the option to put a screw through clamp into tube
