Introduction:

The **Therapy and Special Needs** structures created with the modular components are designed specifically for young children (generally 5 years and under)

The structures are created to encourage specific, general and recreational activities. Ideally the activity can be both therapeutic as well as recreational.

The types of activities generally associated with child therapy include:

- ★ gross motor skills
- ★ balancing
- **★** coordination
- **★** flexibility
- **★** navigation
- ★ muscle training (arm and leg strength)
- ★ environment or spatial awareness

The primary benefit of the modular system is that, within limits, it can be designed and assembled to perform a variety of different functions. By changing a few components, such as with model #850121, one can have 6 variations of the same basic design. While there is such design flexibility, the re-assembly times can vary.
